Deputy Taken To Hospital Following Accident

Fort Myers Beach, FL – A Lee County Sheriff Deputy was transported to the hospital following a vehicle accident on San Carlos Boulevard late Sunday evening. The accident to place in front of 17891 San Carlos Boulevard, Fort Myers Beach Fire Control District’s station number 32. The sound of the collision alerted on duty firefighters to the accident, upon arriving at the scene of the accident firefighters found that two vehicles were involved in the accident, a blue SUV and a Lee County Sheriff’s Office (LCSO) vehicle. The drivers of both vehicles did not appear to be seriously injured as a result of the accident. The deputy was transported to Lee Memorial Hospital as a precaution; the driver of the SUV declined further treatment and was release on the scene.

A north-bound lane of San Carlos Boulevard was shut down for about an hour following the accident; it was reopened following the removal of both vehicles from the roadway. The accident is under investigation by LCSO’s Traffic Unit.
